Arnold Drive at Agua Caliente Intersection Roundabout Project

Sonoma County has proposed a project to construct a roundabout at the intersection of Arnold Drive at Agua Caliente Road, and will prepare an environmental document that analyzes the potential effects of this project on the environment. Request for comments on the environmental effects of the project so Sonoma County, as Lead Agency, can address these concerns in the environmental document.

5. Arnold Drive at Agua Caliente Intersection Roundabout Project **Resolution**

This project will not return to the SVCAC for consideration unless there are major changes, which are not anticipated. The roundabout will be designed to provide 12-foot travel lanes on all legs of the roundabout. Each leg of the intersection will include sidewalks, crosswalks, and bike paths. The roundabout will be designed to adequately accommodate truck turning movements. One leg of the intersection will align with the entrance to the Hanna Boys Center. In addition the project will provide paved shoulders on all legs of the intersection within the project limits.
