Call to Order – Chair Carlsson called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Minutes of the December 4, 2014 Meeting – A correction was made to the minutes to state that “immediate past” Treasure Artists will be allowed free admission to future Treasure Artist events. It was moved by Commissioner Ransom, seconded by Commissioner Schertz to approve the minutes as corrected. The motion carried unanimously.

Student Creative Art Award Program – Chair Carlsson stated she would check on the availability of the Community Center to conduct the student interviews and auditions. Commissioners agreed to schedule the interviews on Friday February 20 3:30 – 5:30 p.m. and Saturday February 21 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. Commissioner Schertz volunteered to arrange the interview schedule.

Commissioner Remarks – Chair Carlsson reported that Kirk Hinshaw, Arts Guild, was continuing to solicit support for development of an Art Walk program. Commissioner Ransom stated that although the Commission discussed raising the admission price for the Treasure Artist reception, no action had been taken. It was moved by Commissioner Ransom, seconded by Commissioner Schertz, to raise the admission to \$25. The motion carried unanimously. Commissioner Schertz requested staff to research if a liquor license was required for the reception.
